

Boise Transitional Care Unit – Riverview Rehabilitation

This facility will provide post-acute care in a distinct more residential and less institutional environment. The facility will be licensed through the State of Idaho department of Health and Welfare as a skilled nursing license. The building is a single story of type V-A construction, fully sprinklered. The facility will have 30 private rooms with associated common areas and support spaces such a laundry, kitchen and dinning areas. A physical therapy space and associated support areas for physical therapy are included as well as administration and conference and counseling rooms

Transitional care is designed for patients who require a short-term regimen of therapy or treatment following an acute hospital stay. It is ideal for patients needing additional therapy services and/or technology-dependent patients who do not need to remain in a medical/surgical bed. Medical conditions which frequently require transitional care include, but are not limited to: Orthopedic Surgery, Stroke, Heart Disease, Amputations, Diabetes, Patient's requiring IV or Wound Care, Dialysis Patients, Post operative observations, Plastic surgery recovery and Pulmonary Conditions.

The facility will have the clinical skill sets to manage these post-acute issues and allow the patient to navigate the course home in a short time period which will typically be 30 days or less stays.
